You can fly to direct to Cardiff airport from many European airports and via Paris, Amsterdam or Doha for international long-haul flights.

Train: If staying in Cardiff City Centre, you can get a train from Cardiff Queen Street Station or Cardiff Central to **Cogan** which is the nearest station to the course venue.


(Approximately 8 minutes train journey and a 5 minute walk to Tec Marina)

Taxi: If staying in Cardiff City Centre or Cardiff Bay, contact Dragon Taxi's (http://dragontaxis.com/) +44 (0) 2920 33 33 33 (Allow a 20 minute journey time in rush hour).

If staying in Penarth, contact Cabs64 http://cabs64.co.uk/ +44 (0) 2920 706464 (Allow a 10 minute journey time in rush hour).

Uber:. Download the app on your phone and fill in the details. Someone can pick you up from your location and take you to Tec Marina, just enter in the postcode as your destination: **CF64 1SA**

Walk: If staying in Cardiff Bay, there is also a beautiful walk along the Cardiff Barrage if the weather allows for this, taking approximately 40 - 50 minutes (this is the long way around). http://www.visitwales.com/things-to-do/activities/walking-hiking/south-wales/cardiff-to-penarth



Pharmacy

The nearest Pharmacy is located in the Tesco store positioned on the roundabout 2 minutes walk from Tec Marina

If you are looking for a pharmacy in the centre of Cardiff. It is recommended to go to a popular cosmetics chain Boots. There are many located around the centre of Cardiff as it is one of the most popular cosmetic and pharmaceutical chains. The green cross is the sign of a pharmacy in the UK.



Emergency services

If you are looking to call the emergency services the following numbers are recommended:

999 - The main emergency number

This is the emergency number for police, ambulance, fire brigade, coastguard, cliff rescue, mountain rescue, cave rescue, etc. Note the important word 'EMERGENCY'. This number should be used only when urgent attendance by the emergency services is required – for example someone is seriously ill or injured, or a crime is in progress.

Calls are free, and 999 can be dialled from a locked mobile phone.



101 - The non-emergency number for the police

Use 101 when you want to contact the police, but it's not an emergency – i.e. an immediate response is not necessary and/or will not be serve any purpose.

For example, your car has been stolen, your property has been damaged, your home has been broken into.

A general rule is "if the crime is not currently in progress, use 101." Yes, we would love an immediate response, but the police have to concentrate their emergency resources on where the criminals are now, not where they were two hours ago.

101 can also be used to give information about a crime committed, or to contact the police with a general enquiry.

You should always call 999 when it is an emergency, such as when a crime is in progress, someone suspected of a crime is nearby, when there is danger to life or when violence is being used or threatened

111 – The non-emergency medical number

This is available nationwide and replaced and expanded on the former NHS Direct service. Use this for illnesses and minor injuries where life isn't threatened, but you would like some advice on what to do next.

Other Information

The local supermarket, Tesco is located on the roundabout near Tec Marina. This is a 2 Minute walk and should contain local produce and other household products you may need during your stay. Tesco is also your nearest Pharmacy and Cashpoint there is also a post box located at Tesco if you were looking to send any mail during your stay.

The Post Office is a local postal service here in the UK, from here you will be able to post any letters you have, purchase stamps or in some select offices, exchange money.

The local one (address below) is available to exchange money. You will be able to exchange your local currency into GBP here. I recommend calling or ordering before you arrive. Other locations such as travel agents should also be available to exchange money. If you are in the centre of Cardiff during your stay, I recommend looking online for your local Post office or travel agent to exchange your money.
